B. Men follow a model man who stands alone.

- 1. Derelicts and debtors came to David (1 Sam. 22:2).
- 2. Christ called common men to be His disciples (Matt. 10:1-4).

C. A true leader leads his men through rigorous training.

- 1. David trained his men while he fled from Saul (1 Sam. 24:6-7).
- 2. Christ trained His men as He overcame the world (Matt. 10:5-25).

D. A true leader teaches his men truth.

- 1. David relied on God and wrote a great hymnody (2 Sam. 23:1-12).
- 2. Christ taught Scripture and revealed new truth (Matt. 5-7).

E. David and Christ's followers became like them, doing great deeds and attaining glory.

- 1. David's men slew giants and did great deeds; their names were entered in a roll call of honor (2 Sam. 23:8-35).
- 2. Christ's men did miracles and died well; their names are written on the Holy City forever (Acts 9:36-43; Rev. 21:14).

III. More About the Model: Mentors and Manuals

Men maximize their productivity (whether commercial, academic, military, or spiritual) in organizations led by men, designed for men, and focused on men. In the past, our society was characterized by such institutions—the military and its academies, law schools, med schools, seminaries, and a great array of gender-segregated social and sporting organizations. Now the professional sports franchises are among the few models left in our society of such exclusively male, highly competitive, and rigorously objective organizations.

Daniel, Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego were enrolled in a Babylonian version of just such an academy designed to produce high-ranking servants for the empire of that day (Dan. 1:3-7). These men excelled in that system and suffered persecution for God in it.

Manuals of Manhood: You can't make men without truth.

Men need objective truth in order to function, to rule the earth, to set goals, to make decisions. Women need truth as well, but they will muddle along with fluid wisdom about relationships, at least for a while. It is men who have suffered first and most with our culture's shift to relativism.

The Bible is the first manual of manhood. It is filled with the masculine

Young men don't marry because they are not manly enough to need wives

This specific challenge is an important part of our overall prayer for men and is an investment in future generations.
